Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you that school closes for the Easter holidays on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March at 2.45pm for students in Year 7 and 8, and 3.30pm for all other year groups. We will be having Easter liturgies for all classes, which will be held during RE lessons throughout the week; other lessons will run as normal. The final day of term will run as a normal school day with pupils expected to wear full school uniform.

On returning to school, pupils will be expected to have all the equipment they need for their lessons and adhere to the school uniform policy; being on holiday is not an excuse for them to come back with dyed hair, lines shaved into their hair or eyebrows, false nails, inappropriate piercings or other breaches of our uniform policy. On days when they have PE, pupils must come in wearing their Maria Fidelis kit; other tracksuits are not permitted, as this is part of the school uniform. School reopens on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> April 2014 at **09.15am for Year 7 and 8 pupils and 10.00am for Yr 9, 10 and 11 pupils** following our Easter break. Please also note that Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> May is a bank holiday, so pupils will not be in school.
