

## **Competition Rules**

- 1. The competition is offered by Maria Fidelis Sixth Form, 34 Phoenix Road, King's Cross, NW1 1TA.
- 2. The competition is sponsored by Costain Skanska Joint Venture (CSJV), Crest of London, 535 Oxford St, Mayfair, London W1K 5JN.
- 3. The competition is open to any current Sixth Form or College student (Y12 or Y13) currently studying in a Camden Sixth Form or College.
- 4. Essays must answer the question How has your environment shaped you?
- 5. Answers can related to a range of topics including, but not limited to, geography, community, the arts, history, transport and infrastructure.
- 6. Essays will be assessed anonymously. Do not include your name anywhere in your actual submission.
- 7. Only one essay per entrant.
- 8. The essay must be the sole creation and original work of the entrant teachers or other staff must not provide support but may consult on the idea.
- 9. Essays must be of approximately 2,000-3,000 words (excluding references and footnotes), typed and in double line spacing and be submitted in Word document format.
- 10. Essays should be submitted via email to <u>mfsixthform@gmail.com</u>, using *MF Essay Competition* as the subject line. Please include your name, year and Sixth Form/College in the body of your email.
- 11. Any form of plagiarism will result in automatic disqualification.
- 12. The deadline for the receipt of entries is 23:59 on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2018. Please note that late entries cannot be accepted.
- 13. Shortlisted entries must be approved by the student's teacher or their Head of Year to warrant that the entrant is eligible for the competition
- 14. Shortlisted entrants will be notified by mid-May.
- 15. The prizes are stated on the poster. The organisation of work experience and experience packages is the responsibility of the winner.
- 16. The judges' decision will be final.
- 17. All entrants grant Maria Fidelis Sixth Form and CSJV the right to publish or reproduce at any time all or part of their essay.
- 18. An Awards Ceremony will be held during the summer term.
- 19. All entries will be acknowledged. Unfortunately, we do not have the capacity to provide feedback on unsuccessful entries.
