Please make sure your child carries the following with them to school at all times:

- Pens, pencils and other stationery equipment which must not be shared
- Water
- Tissues

The guidance on face masks has recently changed but only applies in areas that are in lockdown due to high rates of Covid infection. Face masks are still not recommended in schools but your child will be allowed to wear one if you feel it is necessary.
