
We are taking these reports seriously and want to ensure everyone's safety. As a precaution, we ask that all pupils go straight home once they leave the school site and do not walk alone in the surrounding area. Where possible, pupils should walk home with a known group of friends or be collected by a parent or trusted adult.

We also encourage you to speak with your child about staying alert, avoiding contact with strangers, and seeking help immediately from a trusted adult if they feel uncomfortable or unsafe.

The school will continue to monitor the situation closely and will keep you informed of any further updates. If you have any concerns or notice anything unusual, please report it to the school office.
