**Re: Vapes**

Staff have become aware of a small number of children obtaining vapes and bringing them into school. They are cynically packaged in such a way as to appear attractive to children, but can contain ingredients that are dangerous to health, with the long-term effects still unknown. It is also illegal for anyone to sell vapes to children under the age of 18, and we know that disreputable suppliers are selling unregulated vapes with unknown contents to children.

I am concerned first and foremost about the health and safety of all of our children, and for this reason these items are strictly forbidden. Any child found bringing vapes into school or supplying them to other children will face the strongest sanctions.


There are numerous designs of vapes on the market, and I have included an example of some of them below:
